The Board of Health of Huron County Public Health (HCPH), Huron County, Ohio met at a regular meeting of the Board on August 11th, 2022 in person at Huron County Public Health Conference Room. Norwalk, OH. Board President, Dr. James Gottfried requested a roll call. Mrs. Marks completed a roll call. Dr. Gottfried called the meeting to order at 1:01 pm with quorum present.

Dr. Gottfried opened the meeting with public comment period. With no public comments, Dr. Gottfried proceeded with action items.

Dr. Gottfried presented Resolution 2022-76, a resolution to approve the minutes from the July 2022 regular Board meeting. Dr. Gottfried requested a motion to adopt Resolution 2022-76. Mr. Howard made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 2022 regular Board of Health Meeting, as mailed/emailed. Mrs. Reer seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Gottfried presented Resolution 2022-77, a resolution to approve the payment of the monthly expenditures with prior approval. Dr. Gottfried requested a motion to present Resolution 2022-77. Mr. Polachek made a motion to approve the payment of the monthly expenditures with prior approval. Mrs. Reer seconded the motion. The motion carried upon a roll call vote. study and has been offered a role of Communications Champion to assist the study with implementing community based-health communication campaigns related to Naloxone. The study provides all project champions with a \$250 monthly stipend through the end of December 2023. The stipend will not exceed \$4,500.00. The motion carried upon a roll call vote. The funding from this grant is used to improve failing household sewage treatment systems for county residents based on income application. Dr. Gottfried presented the Fiscal Report, requesting a motion to hear the Fiscal Report. Mr. Howard made a motion, Mr. Polachek seconded the motion, Mrs. Boose reviewed the renovation expenses for Norwalk and Willard locations. Fiscal reports were presented, including the Fund Balance Report and the Revenue and Expense Report. For July, the general fund reflected a cash balance of \$1,069,670. Year to Date Revenue, Year to Date Expense, and balances were also reviewed, Mrs. Boose presented the 2022 General Fund cash balance compared to the previous thirteen year average and proceeded to review the General Fund Budget performance and broke out year-to-date general fund revenue, expense and net details and a comparative review to previous years. Finally, Mrs. Boose reviewed the July Expense highlights, and finally an update on the number of birth and death certificates ordered online utilizing the new software. Dr. Gottfried requested a roll call vote to approve the fiscal report. The motion carried upon roll call vote. Dr. Gottfried-Aye, Mr. Howard-Aye, Mrs. Nedolast- Aye, Mr. Polachek- Aye, Mrs. Reer-Aye, Mr. Robinson-Aye.

Dr. Gottfried introduced Programmatic Presentations:

2020-2022 Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP Release) Dr. Gottfried requested a motion to approve the 2020-2022 Community Health Improvement Plan. Mr. Polacheck made a motion, Mrs. Reer seconded the motion, Mrs. Marks offered further information stating the plan was emailed to the board prior to the board meeting and offered to answer any questions that may have. With no further questions, Dr. Gottfried ask for approval of the 2020-2022 Community Health Improvement Plan. The motion carried unanimously.

This 24-minute training reviewed Corona virus variants and monkey pox current infection and hospitalization rates for Huron County. Also covered was vaccine developments and planning for an increased spread once school begins.

Dr. Gottfried introduced Brittany McClellan, Director for the Health Center of Huron County.

Dr. Gottfried requested a motion to go into Executive Session per Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(2), Mr. Howard made a motion to go into Executive Session, Mr. Polachek seconded the motion.
